

Per Bylaw 110 section 01.1.b, the distribution of seats on Students' Council is determined using the following formula: (Faculty Undergraduate Enrolment / Total Undergraduate Enrolment) X ten (10), then rounded up to the nearest whole number.

The numbers below are taken from the voter roll provided by the Registrar's Office after the Fall 2024 add/drop deadline. [Regulation 110.01: Students' Council Seat Distribution](#) will be as follows. The numbers of seats per faculty are unchanged from the previous year.

Sample Calculation for ALES

24/25 Faculty of ALES Enrollment: 1,774

24/25 Total Undergraduate Enrollment: 36,941

Enrollment Fraction = $1,774/36,941 = 0.048 = 4.8\%$

Enrollment Fraction x 10 = 0.48

We then round this value up to the next whole number, resulting in 1 seat for ALES.
